Shreveport Police Chief Alan Crump



Police Chief Alan Crump

Alan Crump was appointed chief of police by Mayor Ollie Tyler on November 29, 2016 after serving in the capacity of interim chief of police since August 2016. Chief Crump began his career with the Shreveport Police Department in 1992. He currently manages the day-to-day operations of the 800-plus member department.

After graduating from the Police Academy in 1992, Chief Crump was assigned to the Uniform Services Division where he worked as a patrol officer until 1998, when he was reassigned as a school resource officer. He was later certified as a D.A.R.E. instructor and served in that capacity from 1998 to 2009. He was promoted to sergeant in 2008 and later transferred to the community oriented policing bureau in 2009.

Chief Crump was named the supervisor for the department’s Police Pastors Program, Citizens Police Academy, Auxiliary Officers, Reserve Officers, Neighborhood Assistance Team and Youth Programs in 2010. In 2016 he was promoted to lieutenant and was reassigned to the Community Response Unit in the Community Oriented Policing Bureau.

Chief Crump is a certified instructor with the FBI and Louisiana Peace Officer Standards and Training. He hold a bachelor’s degree in criminal justice from LSU-S and an associate of science in criminal justice from Grambling State University.

He served his country honorably as a member of the armed forces; first, as a member of the U.S. Army Reserves and then as an active duty petty officer in the U.S. Navy.
