Keynote

From Rice to Spirits

Founder and owner **Mike Frugé** grew up in Branch, LA on his family's rice farm founded by his great, great uncle. John "JT" Meleck, the family patriarch, started growing "Providence Style" rice in 1896.

Farm life taught Mike to "do it now" as Mother Nature is always changing her mind. Later when Mike was attending college at USL circa 1983 a new farming practice called aquaculture caught the attention of rice farmers. Mike and his brother Mark were one of the first to add live crawfish to flooded rice fields in Acadiana. What started out as a hobby on 20 acres of flooded rice fields is now a thriving rice and crawfish farm that has grown to over 3,000 acres.

The success of the crawfish led Mike to start a self-driven crawfish delivery route in Dallas, Texas. That

single route eventually became the Frugé Seafood Company, a distributor of fresh seafood from all over the world that today serves 3 states and over 500 customers.

In 2013 Mike circled back to focus on the family roots. He began looking for a way to add value to his rice crop and build a lasting brand for his family. Taking rice grown on his farm, he distilled a fine Louisiana Spirit, launching J.T. Meleck Distillers in 2017.

Mike is not all business though-his love for his wife and three kids is second to none. He is a true Louisiana outdoorsman. When not hunting or fishing, you can find him acting as the "semi-professional manager" of a 15 year old baseball player!
