#### **Shreveport's Civil Rights History**



State Representative **Cedric Glover** is a Shreveport native, educated at Caddo Magnet High School . He then attended both Grambling State University and LSU.

Glover was formerly a member in both the Louisiana House of Prepresentatives (1996-2006) and the Shreveport City Council (1990-1996). In 2006 Glover was elected to serve as the Mayor of Shreveport and went on to serve a second term as Mayor.

In 2016 Glover returned to the state House representing District 4 for a second stint of serving, having won outright the position in the primary election held in October 2015.

On Tuesday Rep. Glover will share with us the history of Shreveport's civil rights advances.

Our story begins on the mighty Red River. When early settlers moved into the region now known as Shreveport-Bossier in the early 1800s, it was already occupied by Caddo Native Americans. Shreveport began to prosper when Captain Henry Miller Shreve and his brigade broke up the Great Raft clogging the Red River. From then on, Shreveport-Bossier became an epicenter of wild west shenanigans, Victorian-era dramas, Rock 'N' Roll history, and pivotal civil rights strides.

This month we are celebrating Juneteenth which takes place annually on June 19th and marks the true end of slavery in the United States. Last year, President Joe Biden signed the Juneteenth National Indep0endence Day Act making the day a federal holiday.


