For many years our club has been awarding civic grants to local non-profit organizations to assist with a particular project that they have. This year our grant committee began soliciting grant applications in December 2019.

The results of our committee's selection were announced several weeks ago. \$22,800 was available for the awards this year.

These awards are funded through our dues structure with assistance from the Rotary Club of Shreveport Foundation, our 501 (c)(3) organization. We received a total of 25 grant applications for a total request of \$99,346.00.

The top ranked applicants and their awards are these:

\$5,000—The Arc of Caddo Bossier GREAT Program
\$4,000—David Raines Community Health Center
\$4,000—Heart of Hope
\$4,000—Sci-Port Discovery Center
\$4,000—Community Renewal

Receiving \$300 speaker honorariums are these organizations: Shreveport Bossier Rescue Mission, Goodwill Industries of North Louisiana, United Way of Northwest Louisiana, Girls on the Run-Shreveport, AMIKids Caddo and Renzi Education and Arts Center.

Messages from President Rich Brontoli

Our Rotary District 6190 is giving away 3 additional grants, to be used for club projects in our local communities. The club with the largest per capita dollar increase from 5/22 until the end of June will get a \$3000 grant, second largest dollar increase will get a \$2000 grant and third largest dollar increase will get a \$1000 grant.

To encourage our members to donate the District has 30,000 points available to match one point for each new dollar members give to the Rotary Foundation between 5/22 and June 19, up to a maximum of 500 points per member.

This can make a new Paul Harris Fellow (PHF) for \$500 or if you are close to your first PHF or looking to get to the next level, get there twice as fast. This offer is only good until June 19th, so we can get credit for this Rotary year.

Our Shreveport Club will also use our points; EXAMPLE: If a member, who between now and June 19, donates \$335, we will match that with 330 club points, district will match with 335 points and you get a PHF or a level up.

We will take any amount and match it, i.e. - you give \$100, Club gives 100 and District 100.


Something We Probably Don't Know: I was a news reporter for several years before moving into PR. My first—and probably favorite—job was at historic KWKH Radio.
