At the Shreveport FEC, professionally trained FEC counselors help individuals and families manage their

finances, pay down debt, increase savings, establish and build credit, and access safe and affordable mainstream banking products.


At the core of the FEC model is the integration of counseling into other social services, such as housing and foreclosure prevention, workforce development, prisoner reentry, benefits access, domestic violence services and more.

On Tuesday we will hear from Bruce Willson, President and CEO of United Way of Northwest Louisiana and from Rashida Dawson, Vice President of Financial Stability. Bruce is a long term Rotarian in our club and served Rotary District 6190 as District Governor in 2008-2009. 

COVID-19 Activities: Moved to transitioning all the JA USA programs to online. In May 2020,


