On Tuesday we will be back in our regular meeting room to hear from **Warren Stephens**, Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer of Stephens, Inc. based in Little Rock.

Stephens is a graduate of Washington and Lee University where he received his B.A. in economics. He later received his MBA from Wake Forest University.

Stephens began his investment banking career as an associate in the corporate finance department at Stephens, Inc. Later, he was Senior Vice President of the Capital Markets Group and was named President and Chief Executive Officer in 1986.

In addition to his duties at Stephens, Inc. he has served on the NASD District Conduct Committee; currently serves on the Board of Directors of Dillard's Inc. and is a former member of the Board of Trustees at Washington and Lee University.

Active in community and civic affairs, he is a past chairman of the board of the Arkansas Arts Center and is currently a member of the Arkansas Arts Center Foundation Board, as well as a former chairman. He is chair of Episcopal Collegiate School Foundation Board and a former member of the Board of Directors for the Central Arkansas Boys and Girls Club.
