### **Shreveport Property Standards**

Mortimer Harris, a native of Shreveport, is the Deputy Director of Property Standards for the City of Shreveport. He began working for the City in 2002 as a Plans Examiner and was promoted to his current position in 2019.

Mr. Harris received his degree in business management from Southern University in Baton Rouge. He serves as Vice President of the local Alpha Xi Sigma chapter of the national Phi Beta Sigma organization.

The City's Property Standards prime responsibility is to protect the safety and welfare of the community by working to reverse and alter trends of deterioration in our neighborhoods.

Some of the possible issues handled by Property Standards are:

- Nuisance/Care of Premises such as property having junk, trash, debris, building material, car parts, dismantled vehicles, etc.
- Residential substandard structures such as a dilapidated house, structures with roof caving in, fire damage, deteriorated porches, etc.
- Inoperable vehicles
- Non-residential substandard buildings
- Overgrown property
- Unsecure vacant dwellings, buildings
- Boat houses and piers


## **Last Week's Program**
