The Bayou Classic Is Coming To Town!

Kelly Wells has been with the Shreveport-Bossier Sports Commission since its creation in 2012 by the cities of Shreveport and Bossier City, Caddo and Bossier Parishes as a division of the Shreveport Bossier Convention and Tourist Bureau.

Before that, Kelly was in hotel sales management for the previous six years in Louisiana, Texas and Tennessee. A native of Tyler, Texas, he graduated from East Texas Baptist University in Marshall, TX and has two graduate degrees: Master of industrial and organizational psychology from Louisiana Tech and his MBA from Centenary College.

sic is the annual college football game between the Grambling State University Tigers and the Southern University Jaguars. The game was first held under that name in 1974 at Tulane Stadium in New Orleans although the series itself actually began in 1932.



This annual event is so much more than a football game. It commemorates historically black colleges and universities, academic achievement, tradition, sportsmanship, marching bands, and friendly competition. The "Classic" is an exhibition of the high standards of academic achievement deeply embedded in the traditions of the two institutions.

The Rotaract, Youth Exchange Officer and Inter-Country Committee preconventions will be held 10-11 June 2021. The cost of each preconvention event is \$20.
