Congressman Mike Johnson

Congressman Mike Johnson is a Republican member of Congress proudly serving Louisiana's Fourth District. He represents nearly 760,000 residents of 15 parishes in the northwest and western regions of the state. He was appointed to the House Judiciary Committee and two of its subcommittees. He also serves on the House Natural Resources Committee and the Subcommittee on Water, Power and Oceans.

A dedicated husband and father of four, Mike is a constitutional law attorney. He served in the Louisiana Legislature from 2015-2017.

The eldest son of a Shreveport fire fighter who was critically burned and disabled in the line of duty, Mike learned early on the values of hard work, honor and sacrifice. He was also a conservative talk radio host and columnist, a media

spokesman for America's largest religious liberty organizations, a constitutional law seminar instructor and a board member and legal counsel for many organizations.

Congressman Johnson earned his J.D. from the Paul M. Hebert Law Center at LSU where he was a member of the Moot Court Board and National Moot Court Team. He was elected class president. He earned his undergraduate degree in business administration from LSU where he was selected to Leadership LSU and the Order of Omega Honor Society, Kappa Sigma Fraternity and served as president of the LSU Interfraternity Council.

Mike and his wife Kelly, a former school = teacher from Webster Parish, have four children. They reside in Bossier Parish.




