Update from Washington, D.C.



Congressman Mike Johnson

Elected in November 2016 **Congressman Mike Johnson** is a Republican member of Congress serving Louisiana's 4th District. He was appointed to the House Judiciary Committee and two of its subcommittees—the Subcommittee on Immigration and Border Security and the House Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, Homeland Security and Investigations. In addition, he is on the House Natural Resources Committee.

Before moving into the national arena, Congressman Johnson served in the Louisiana Legislature from 2015 to January 2017 where he received top awards from business and industry, limited govern-

ment and pro-life and pro-family groups.

Mike is the eldest son of a Shreveport firefighter who was critically burned and disabled in the line of duty. He is a conservative talk radio host and columnist, a media spokesman for America's largest religious liberty organizations, a constitutional law seminar instructor and a board member for national organizations and numerous community groups.

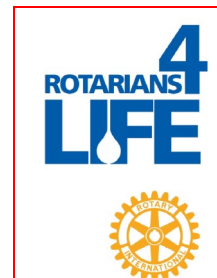

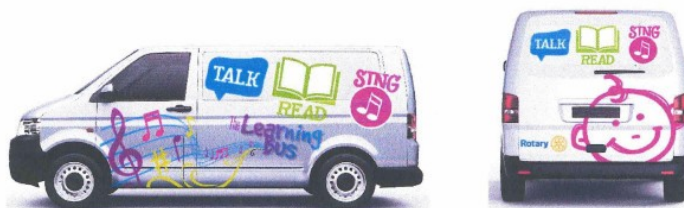
Last Tuesday, **John Tuggle** was recognized for his support of The Rotary Foundation when President Joe presented him with his PHF+2 lapel pin.
