Gregory attended the University of Texas and received a B.S. in film. He also attended the film program at the University of Southern California. Prior to his breakout documentary *Haynesville: A Nation's Hunt for an Energy Future*, Gregory directed *Eating Levi*, an internationally successful film about Levi Oliver and his quest for competitive eating fame.
