Economic Development in Shreveport



Drew Mouton serves as the Director of the Office of Economic Development at the City of Shreveport. He has nearly three decades of direct experience leading both planned and unplanned change in business and industry, government, education and healthcare. His focus is on economic impact, team-building, innovation and execution.

Since 2010 he has directed much of his attention to higher education and public service. He has been an advisor to the Levy-Rosenblum In-

stitute for Entrepreneurship, serving as its Lean Startup subject matter expert.

He developed and led multiple programs at Tulane before serving as Technology Architect for the Cyber-Collaboratory initiative at LSUS, then as Chief Innovation Officer for LSU Health Shreveport, leading pandemic response initiatives that served half the State. Along the way Mouton led campus seminars and taught university classes in management, strategy, new venture planning, applied innovation and management of entrepreneurial ventures.

Mouton received his B.A./B.S degrees in French and molecular biology from Tulane University. His MBA and Masters in Global Management were from the A.B. Freeman School of Business at Tulane.


