Update on the LSU Health Sciences Center



Dr. G.E. Ghali

Dr. G.E. Ghali was named Chancellor of LSU Health Shreveport and Dean of the LSU School of Medicine by the LSU president F. King Alexander on October 7, 2016. Dr. Ghali had served as the interim Chancellor and Dean for the previous eight months.

Dr. Ghali is also the professor and chairman of the Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (OMS) Department and the holder of the Jack W. Gamble Endowed Chair. He serves on national and international organizations for the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons (AAOMS), American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (ABOMS), and International Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons (IAOMS). His association with these organizations is recognized as shaping the profession of oral and maxillofacial surgery, as well as bringing

international recognition for the LSU Shreveport OMS residency and fellowship programs.

For the past 23 years, Dr. Ghali has lived and practiced in Shreveport. His practice spans from primary cleft repair to cosmetic surgery to head and neck cancer. He is involved in clinical and basic science research and is widely published in peer-reviewed journals. He has contributed to and edited textbooks that are vital to the knowledge base of many in the specialty.

He and his wife, Hope, have four children.

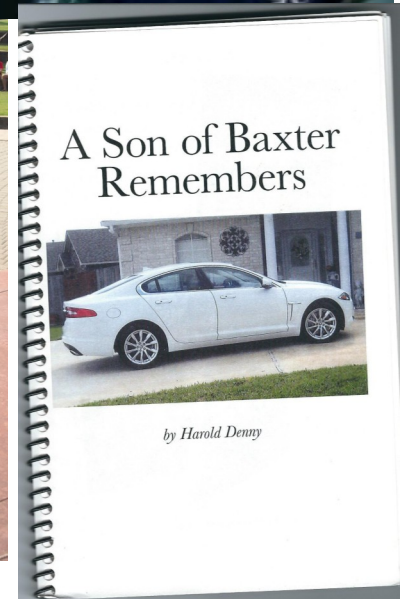
