**Barry Erwin** is a Louisiana native who was named President of the Council for A Better Louisiana in 2001. From 1995 to 2001 he served first as a consultant to CABL and later as Sr. Vice President. He has more than 30 years of experience in the public affairs, policy and political arenas.

Prior to joining CABL Mr. Erwin spent 15 years as a broadcast journalist working for media outlets in Shreveport and Baton Rouge. He specialized in covering state government and politics and served for six years as Capitol Correspondent for WBRZ-TV in Baton Rouge. His work as a journalist has garnered state, regional, and national awards.

Upon leaving journalism Mr. Erwin worked for five years as a public affairs consultant and was involved in issues such as education, health care and the judiciary. Mr. Erwin is a graduate of Louisiana Tech University with a degree in journalism. He is active in the Baton Rouge community and has served on the Board of Directors of Baton Rouge Youth and is Past President of the ARC of Baton Rouge.

Chairman of the Board at CABL is local attorney **Malcolm Murchison**, founding member of the law firm Bradley Murchison Kelly & Shea, LLC with offices in Shreveport, Baton Rouge and New Orleans. He has been regularly named to the list of Best Lawyers in America since 2010 and been recognized many times for his work in the fields of real estate, energy and natural resources.

He is active in the Shreveport community—past chair of the Biomedical Research Foundation; the Greater Shreveport Chamber of Commerce; the Shreveport Bossier Convention and Tourist Bureau; and Dean's Advisory Council for the Louisiana Tech College of Busi-

ness. He is an alumnus of Louisiana Tech University and the LSU Paul M. Hebert Law Center.


