Pat earned his B.A. degree in political science and government from Texas Tech University and received his Air Force commission through the ROTC program there. He retired from the Air Force as a Brig. General in 2012. He is a command pilot with 3,300 hours in T-37, T-38 and A-10 aircraft.

During his Air Force career, Pat prepared for his life after retirement by securing his Certified Financial Planner designation. He is the co-founder of Pinnacle Asset Management Corp.

Pat is involved with the Shreveport-Bossier Military Affairs Council and volunteers with the Wounded Warrior Project.
