Scott currently serves as a director of the 5,000 member International Economic Development Council. He also serves as an instructor in the True South Economic Development course held annually at the Trent Lott Center at the University of Southern Mississippi.

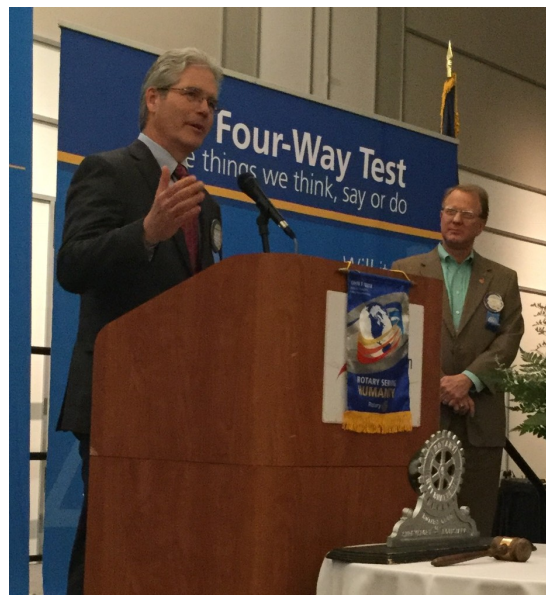


Carlton Golden received his PHF+1 and PHF+2 pins last Tuesday. He moved up two levels in his giving to The Rotary Foundation.
