Barksdale Air Force Base Update



Colonel Michael A. Miller

Colonel Michael A. Miller is the commander of the 2nd Bomb Wing at Barksdale Air Force Base. He is responsible for providing combat-ready B-52H aircraft, crews, and associated combat support to conduct global operational taskings.

Colonel Miller received his commission through the Reserve Officer Training Corps in 1994 and has served in a variety of flying and staff positions. He is a published author of two Congressional Research Reports to Congress, is a graduate of the USAF's Weapons School, and holds masters' degrees from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, Air Command and Staff College and The School of Advance Air and Space Studies.

Prior to his current assignment, he was the Director, Joint-Global Strike Operations Center at Barksdale. He is a B-52 and B-1 weapon systems officer with more than 2,400 hours, including more than 700 combat hours in Operations Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom.

Miller has received numerous Major Awards and Decorations.
