



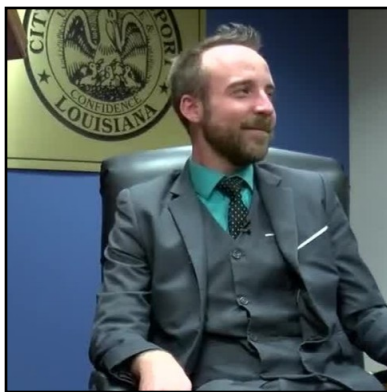

Shreveport's Real Time Crime Center

Shreveport's Real Time Crime Center (RTCC) has been up and running since September 2021. With 24 hours a day 7 days a week staffing, this new program will help Shreveport police officers with the amount of manpower and emergency calls.

When a police officer is dispatched to a call the camera capability can provide real-time information like vehicle description, the location, layout of the location and information on the person. The City is depending on the community (residents and business owners) to help by signing up to share their surveillance data services with law enforcement agencies and first responders.

This allows the RTCC to bring in camera feeds everywhere from HOA, businesses and residences to cameras on poles, even the DOTD cameras that stream the highways.

Keith Hanson is the first Chief Technology Officer for the City of Shreveport. He has been on the job since January 2019. He has a lengthy background in open-source software and hardware, automation processes and application development. He is a Bossier native and Airline High School graduate who began writing software when he was 12 years old. In addition to being a juggler (really!), he has received several awards for his technology.

Kevin Thomas is the manager of the City's new Real Time Crime Center. He is a life-long resident of Shreveport, grew up in the Queensboro neighborhood and graduated from Fair Park High School. He received his Associate Degree in criminal justice from Bossier Parish Community College and then continued at Northwestern State University where he received his bachelor's degree. He has 18 years experience as a police officer and corrections officer.
