They specialize in the development and dissemination of leading-edge scientific research, knowledge, and best practices that improve teaching and increase student learning.

With an in-the-trenches approach, the Center tackles real-time issues such as ways to remediate struggling readers, differentiate instruction for diverse learners, and build and sustain collective capacity.

Dr. Wyble is also the President and Founder of Leadership Concepts, specializing in executive services, organizational assessment and development, team

building and long term planning.

Since 2011 Dr. Wyble has served on the Washington Parish School Board and is currently in his third term as President of that Board. He received his Masters degree in vocational education from LSU and his PhD in leadership and research from the University of Southern Mississippi.


