Caroline Hendrix, a Shreveport native, is the Director of The ARC Caddo-Bossier's GREAT program (Great Results Equine Assisted Therapies). She has been with The ARC for 20 years and is a PATH (Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship) international instructor.

After graduating from C.E. Byrd High School, Caroline attended and graduated from Western State College of Colorado with a degree in recreation emphasizing in outdoor education. She is happy to be in her hometown where she is raising her 15 year old daughter and 10 year old son.

Since 1997, ARC's GREAT Program has been offering therapeutic horseback riding services to children and adults with disabilities. This program positively affects the

physical, cognitive and social well-being of its students. They offer diverse programs to local schools and hospitals, as well as private lessons and inclusive summer camps.

GREAT is located in a new state-of-theart facility on the Greenwood-Springridge Road in Greenwood, LA. The organization's instructors are trained to teach students with a variety of disabilities including, but not limited to downs syndrome, cerebral palsy and traumatic brain injury.



Our civic grant committee awarded a \$5,000 grant in 2019-2020 to GREAT to have two loafing sheds built in two of their pastures. These three-sided shelters are available when the horses enter at will to get out of bad weather.
