Caring For Oriental Rugs!

Rotarian **Jarrold Horton** is a lifelong resident of Shreveport who received his degree in business management from Centenary College in 1992. While there, he was with the Centenary Choir.

Jarrold and wife Michele own a local pest control company, Anti-Pest, which was previously owned by J.T. May an active member of our club. Jarrold has been with Anti-Pest for 28 years, even before he became an owner and before he graduated from Centenary.

Since 2013 Jarrold and Michele have owned Porter's Carpet Cleaners with his brother Shawn Horton. After purchasing this company from another local family, the Hortons invested in new equipment designed to provide state of the art cleaning of oriental rugs with a focus on correcting problems caused by pets. Both Jarrold and Shawn went through extensive training to become Louisiana's only certified master rug cleaners.

Since joining our club in 2013, Jarrold served on our Board of Directors in 2016-2017, is a Paul Harris Fellow and serves on several committees. He and Michele have three children.
