2019 COUNCIL ON LEGISLATION ESSENTIAL CHANGES FOR CLUBS AND DISTRICTS

Rotary International conducts a Council on Legislation every three years where the Council's delegates propose and vote on recommended changes to current Rotary procedures or to enact new procedures. Every district in the world is represented by a delegate elected by each district.

These are some of the changes that have been made by Rotary International that might be of interest to you:

<u>Make-up attendance</u>: Rotarians can make up for an absence at the club meeting within the same Rotary year. (This rule previously was 14 days before or after a missed meeting. However, since Rotary has more or less discontinued the attendance requirement, this is a moot point except for those Rotarians who strive for 100% attendance.)

<u>Club dues increased</u>: In 2019-2020 members dues are now \$68 per year which will increase by a small amount through 2022-2023. (Our club is able to absorb these increased dues without affecting our member dues at this time. Note that there are additional dues charged by Rotary for insurance, Council on Legislation assessments and such. Our Rotary District also charges clubs with dues per capita.)

<u>Rotaract clubs</u>: These clubs are now members of Rotary International just as are Rotary clubs. There are no operational charges for them nor for their sponsoring Rotary Clubs. This provision elevates the status of Rotaract clubs.

<u>Classification</u>: The classification limitation has been removed, so clubs may now determine for themselves the appropriate number of members in a particular classification. In addition, elected or appointed public officials are no longer prohibited from joining a club using the classification associated with their office.

There are other changes made by the Council on Legislation but these listed above are the ones most pertinent to our club. Let Judy Bellew know if you would like a complete set of the changes.
