Keynote Police Chief Ben Raymond Shreveport Police Department

Ben Raymond began his career with the Shreveport Police Department in February 2000. After graduating from the Shreveport Police Regional Training Academy in June of that year, he worked in the Uniform Services Division as a patrol officer.

He was selected to be a member of the Street Level Interdiction Unit (narcotics) in June of 2002 and was assigned a dual role as an operator with the Special Response Team. He served in this capacity until September 2005 when he was transferred to the Mid-Level Investigations Unit (narcotics) and continued in his duties as an operator with the Special Response Team. As he progressed in his career he was ultimately appointed as the Special Response Team training coordinator and was responsible for ensuring the team was properly trained and equipped.



He was transferred to the Shreveport Police Regional Training Academy as an instructor in 2016. During his tenure as an instructor, he was promoted to the rank of police sergeant.

In 2017 he was appointed chief administrative assistant where he was primarily responsible for the creation, implementation and management of the police budget. He was appointed chief of police by Mayor Adrian Perkins in September 2019 after accepting a substitute appointment as chief of police in 2018.

Chief Raymond received his B.A. in criminal justice, summa cum laude and was the top graduate during the 1999 commencement for ULM in Monroe. He holds numer-



ous certifications in firearms, battle safety and other tactical certifications.

He considers his greatest accomplishment and most important role is being a loving father for his two daughters.



Libby reported that she used to work with Al Kessler and he was a wonderful person to know. She was very honored to have been selected for this award.




