Pamela Brown is a native of north Louisiana who retired to Shreveport after 23 years as a special agent with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA).

Originally recruited out of New Orleans from a job in the medical field, Pamela cut her teeth as a young agent working cases in Miami where, at the time, cocaine was literally falling out of the skies. Later assignments took her around the world to the jungles of Bolivia, the opium markets of Thailand, and finally agency headquarters in Washington, D.C.

As a special agent with DEA, Pamela's work included under cover assignments, organizing and implementing high-level drug operations, and cultivating informants. Having worked the streets of Miami during the cocaine hey-day, Ms. Brown is sought out by actors and authors researching roles and subject matter. She has consulted with Gabriel Union, Dana Delaney and Patricia Cornwell to name a few.

This former DEA agent traded in jungle raids and cocaine busts for retirement in Shreveport. She now enjoys adventure vacations, foreign travel, cycling and anything else that will get her heart rate up.
