

Update on LSU Shreveport

He rejoined LSUS after serving as Dean of the business schools at UNC Wilmington for four years, Sonoma State University for six years and LSU Shreveport for nine years. Prior to academia, Clark was an Army Captain/Judge Advocate.


New Experience
