L. Lawrence Brandon serves as Senior Pastor and CEO of Praise Temple. He is the Third Presiding Bishop of the Full Gospel Baptist Church Fellowship International. Brandon is a highly motivated minister, mentor, counselor, speaker and spiritual leader who is also the founder/organizer of L.L. Brandon Ministries. Inc.

Brandon served as the chairman of the Shreveport Regional Airport Authority Board and resigned after being elected to the Louisiana State Ethics Board. He is a chaplain to the LA State Police, Caddo Parish District Attorney Office and the Shreveport City Marshals Office.

An Air Force veteran, Brandon is also a member of the Step Forward Initiative and serves on many community Boards. He is

a member of our club and a multi-level Paul Harris Fellow.

Brandon will bring us up to date on the reentry programs available that are designed to work toward reducing recidivism through behavioral treatment, substance abuse treatment, life skills training, anger management skills and family relationship reconciliation.


