### Caddo Parish Schools



Dr. T. Lamar Goree

The longest serving superintendent in more than 30 years, **Dr. T. Lamar Goree** brought innovation and stabilization to Caddo Parish Public Schools, a district of nearly 37,000 students with 58 schools including three charter agreements.

When Dr. Goree arrived in Caddo in December 2013 to lead his hometown district, he brought with him the experiences of his time in districts in Texas to turn the tide facing the district he knew and loved. Faced by looming state takeover of 10 schools, he established the Transformation Zone which provided specialized supports, training and leadership to the district's most

consistently underperforming schools.

He began his career as a math teacher in Marietta, Georgia, following in the footsteps of his mother and father who were career educators in Caddo Parish Public Schools. A rising star for his ability to engage and inspire his students, Dr. Goree was recruited to serve in Fort Worth, Texas as a math teacher where he quickly gained a following, moving up into increasingly critical administrative roles in the Mansfield (TX) ISD.

After graduating from high school in Caddo Parish Public Schools, he attended Morehouse College where he received his B.A. degree. His M.Ed in school leadership and his PhD in educational leadership and policy studies were both earned at the University of Texas at Arlington.

Among his many honors, Dr. Goree was named 2019 Louisiana State Superintendent of the Year. Lamar became a Rotarian in our club in early 2014 shortly after his arrival to Caddo Parish. He is a Paul Harris Fellow and attends meetings regularly.



5:30 p.m.—Community comes to the Fellowship Hall (where we have packed the boxes) and they grab a meal to go. As volunteers return, the community will have the option of dining in and the volunteers will help service and clean up the dining area.

5:30 p.m.—The food pantry will open and residents can "shop" to get the items they want. Volunteers are needed to be "personal shoppers" to help them carry their food through the market and help them to their cars. These boxes won't be as heavy as the car line distribution has been. This distribution is usually done by 6:45 p.m.

course.


I know there's only five cans here but Joe needed to make sure that you'd enjoy these so he did a taste test first!








