John M. Schroder was elected Louisiana State Treasurer in November 2017. As Treasurer, he oversees more than \$6 billion in investments and over \$38 billion in cash flow. He also chairs the Louisiana State Bond Commission and returns millions of dollars in unclaimed property to Louisiana citizens.

Treasurer Schroder was first elected to the Louisiana House of Representatives in 2007 to represent St. Tammany and Tangipahoa Parishes. After 10 years in the Legislature, he resigned his seat to run for State Treasurer.

John is a graduate of East Jefferson High School, Southeastern Louisiana University and is a U.S. Army veteran. He is a businessman, co-owner of a real estate company and a residential developer. He has been married to Ellie Daigle Schroder for 33 years.



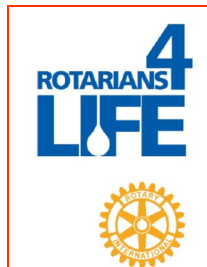

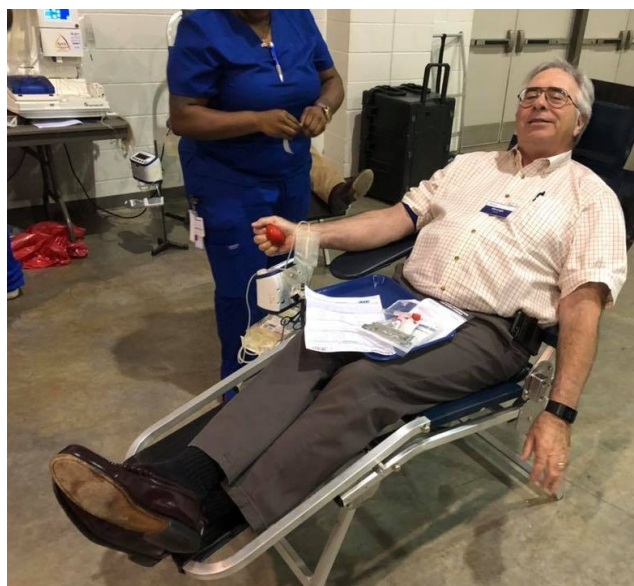
