For many years our club has been awarding civic grants to local non-profit organizations to assist with a particular project that they have. This year our grant committee began soliciting grant applications in December 2018.

The results of this committee's selection were announced several weeks ago. \$22,800 was available for the civic grants this year.

These awards were funded through our dues structure.

The top ranked applicants and their projects are these:

\$3,000—Volunteers for Youth Justice—Support for CASA Recruiter/Trainer

\$4,000—Gingerbread House—Operational support

\$4,000—Holy Angels—Technical equipment for residents

\$3,000—Literacy Volunteers at Centenary College—Study materials, computer

\$4,000—InterCity Entrepreneur Institute—BizCamp program

\$1,500—Shreveport Opera—Support of SOX program

\$1,500—Louisiana Association for the Blind—Youth transition program

Receiving \$300 speaker honorariums are these organizations: Caddo Bossier Rescue Mission, Providence House, Operation Home Front, Strand Theater, Goodwill Industries and Herndon Magnet Schools.

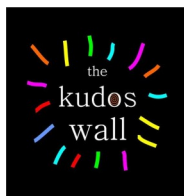

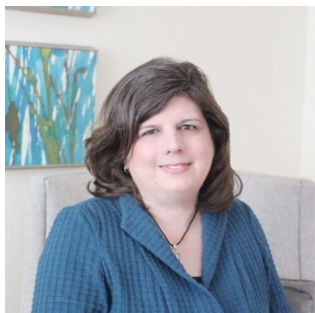

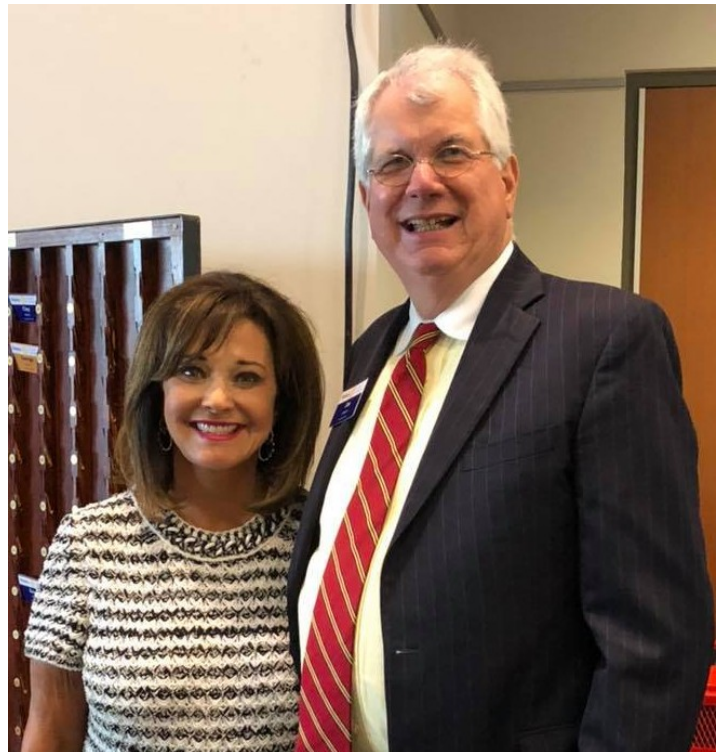
