He is currently enrolled at LSUS in the Masters program in Nonprofit Administration.

Jeff is an Eagle Scout, a Vigil Honor Member of the Order of the Arrow, earned the BSA Professional Circle Award, and has served in several national Scouting committees and task forces including being the Course

Director of the National Camping School three times, a counselor in the Scout Executive Certification Program, and serving as a guest speaker at Scouting University for other Scouting professionals and volunteers.

After serving in several increasingly responsible Scouting positions, he was named the Scout Executive/CEO of the Norwela Council in Shreveport in November 2019.

Locally he is an advisory board member of the Institute for Nonprofit Administration & Research at LSUS, a member of Barkus and Meoux, the North Louisiana Chapter of the Association of Fundraising Professionals and the Auburn Alumni Society. He is a graduate of Leadership Shreveport where he now serves as a Junior Coordinator and is on the Leadership Advisory Board of that program.

Jeff was a member of the Rotary Club of Rome, Georgia. Shortly after he relocated to our area, he joined our club. He is a Paul Harris Fellow.


