





The **Virginia K. Shehee Most Influential Woman Award** is named for a civic leader, businesswoman, and philanthropist Virginia K. Shehee, who passed away in 2015, after decades of service to Northwest Louisiana. Virginia was one of the first women admitted to our club after Rotary International changed their By-Laws and allowed women to become members in 1987.

This event, sponsored by The Shreveport Times and Red River Bank, honors women and students who have made significant contributions to our community. The credentials for recipients include women who have shown a commitment to philanthropy by helping children, the elderly, those in need, the arts, business development, education or other acts of caring through unpaid positions.



Certificate of Appreciation
