Prior to becoming the YMCA's CEO, Gary coached high school basketball in Bossier Parish for four years., then began a successful sales and management career in the oil and gas industrial supply industry.

The YMCA's presence in Shreveport dates back to the 1860's and in 1888, funds were raised to construct a three story building that housed the city's first gym, located at Milam and Edwards St. This building was later sold and funds were raised to construct the current Downtown Y which opened in 1925.

In 2017, the BHP Billiton YMCA was opened on Knight St. at the Clyde Fant Parkway's Preston St. exit.

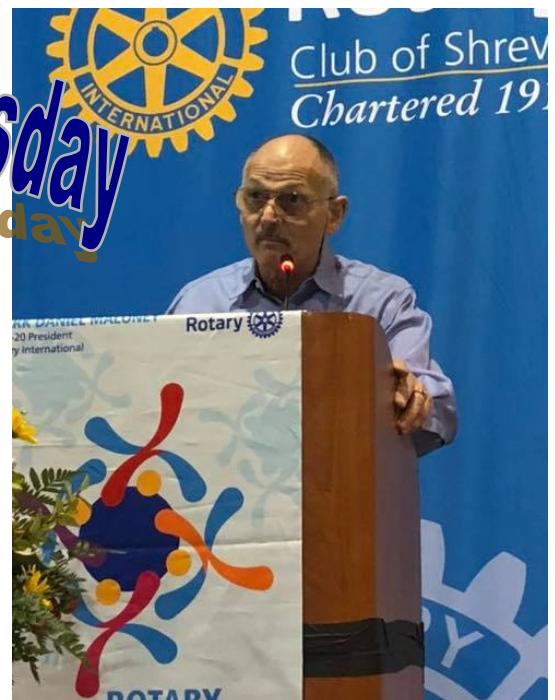
