# Medical Research In Our Backyard



Dr. Christopher Kevil

Vice Chancellor for Research Christopher G. Kevil, Ph.D. assumed leadership for research development and management of the LSU Health Sciences Center in December 2016. He was named Dean, School of Graduate Studies in September 2017.

He earned his graduate research degree from LSU Health Shreveport in molecular and cellular physiology followed by a fellowship in pathobiology and functional genomics at the University of Alabama-Birmingham. After his return to LSU Health, new technologies discovered in the Kevil Lab led to development of two startup companies—Theravasc, Inc. located in Cleveland, Ohio and Innolyzer, LLC located in Shreveport.


Dr. Kevil is a member of many professional organizations and the recipient of numerous research and

teaching awards. He also serves on several boards, serves as the editor-in-chief for the Redox Biology Journal and associated editor for the American Journal of Pathology.
