Large Project Completed Rotary Learning Bus partnership with Common Ground Community

Four years ago through a competitive selection process our club members voted to support a multi-year project with Common Ground Community. We have concluded that \$125,000 project this year. The first year we spent \$50k on the purchase of the Rotary Learning Bus, van wrap, insurance, flags and banners. The next three years we committed \$25k per year for various Learning Bus projects. With the COVID outbreak when the community was in stay at home mandates and remote school learning, Common Ground was able to use part of those funds to provide food baskets/fresh fruits and vegetables to the Cedar Grove residents.

Lisa Cronin, the CEO of Common Ground, accepted our final check on Tuesday. She provided a recap of the activities that they have held during this past year.

Dear Fellow Rotarians,

As one of the world's largest humanitarian organizations, Rotary has made peace the cornerstone of our global mission. We are deeply concerned about the Ukraine crisis and need your help.
