On Tuesday Austin Beard, clinical manager at Urgent Care of Louisiana, will give us information and statistics on this flu season.

A Capt. Shreve graduate, Mr. Beard received his BS degree in emergency medical services from Western Carolina University. He spent the early part of his career at the Children's Medical Center in Dallas as their facility coordinator manager. In addition, he served on the faculty at the University of Texas instructing paramedic and EMT students.

In 2006 Austin returned home to Shreveport and de-

veloped the Louisiana Emergency Response Network for the State of Louisiana. More recently Beard served on the faculty at BPCC and as call center supervisor for the Louisiana Emergency Response Network.


In 2010 he helped to open and manage Urgent Care of Louisiana in Shreveport

He maintains his Nremt-P (National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians-Paramedic) designation which certifies him to provide advanced emergency medical care for critical and emergent patients who access the emergency medical system. Beard also works as a part time firefighter and paramedic with Caddo Fire District Five.


