Financial Empowerment Center



Rashida Dawson is the Vice President of Financial Stability of United Way of Northwest Louisiana and is responsible for the overall leadership and management of its Financial Stability impact area.

Her latest project includes the management of the Shreveport Financial Empowerment Center (FEC), a partnership of the Mayor's Office and United Way of Northwest Louisiana.

The Center provides professional, one-on-

one financial counseling and coaching as a free public service to local residents. Professionally trained FEC counselors help individuals and families manage their finances, pay down debt, increase savings, establish and build credit, and access safe and afford-

able mainstream banking products. At the core of the FEC model is the integration of counseling into other social services, such as housing and foreclosure prevention, workforce development, prisoner reentry, benefits access, domestic violence services, and more.

Rashida earned her bachelor's degree in marketing from ULM in Monroe and is currently pursuing her MBA from LSUS.

Fulfilling her commitment to serve others, Rashida is the current president of the South Shreveport Rotary Club, member of BancorpSouth's CRA Advisory Council, Northwest Louisiana Re-Entry Coalition and the Young Professionals Initiative. Among other things, she is a graduate of the 2017 Greater Shreveport Leadership Program, 2013 graduate of LANO's Leadership Program. She was recognized as part of the 2018 Class of Forty Under 40 and was the first recipient of the Nonprofit Citizen of the Year for the 2019 Minority Business Opportunity Awards through the Greater Shreveport Chamber of Commerce.




