

Mayor Lorenz "Lo" Walker is in his fourth term as mayor of Bossier City. He drew no opposition for the 2017 election and he has announced to his staff that it is his intention to run for re-election in 2021.

At this point with his fourth term, Mayor Walker is tied with the deceased former mayor George Dement.

Walker graduated with his MBA from Auburn University and served 30 years retiring at the rank of colonel in the U.S. Air Force, with ratings as a command pilot and master parachutist.




