Paulette Freeman moved two years ago from Little Rock to Shreveport where she is currently the Executive Director of The Bridge Alzheimer's & Dementia Resource Center. While in Little Rock, she was the former Executive Director of Arkansas Blood Institute, where she managed the daily operations of the non-profit blood bank for Central Arkansas for four years.

Prior to this leadership position, she was the Director of Business Development for The Poultry Federation in Little Rock for 10 years. She served as an honorary commander of the Little Rock Air Force Base. Paulette was named in the 2018 *Arkansas Business Journal, Arkansas 250* publication as one of the

state's top influential business leaders. She is a graduate of the University of the Ozarks with a bachelor's degree in Business Administration. She serves on the Alumni Association board of directors and is a recipient of their Alumni Achievement Award.

In 2007, **Stacey Hand** began caring for an older loved one. After realizing that there was not a lot of helpful information for caregivers, she enrolled in the Masters of Gerontology program at ULM and finished her degree program in 2011. During that time she also worked at a local retirement community expanding the scope of issues she learned to evaluate and resolve...putting what she was learning in her classes to the test in real time.

She opened Handle with Care Elder Services in 2012 and is a consultant with The Bridge as well as other non-profits doing Board of Directors training, de-

signing training modules, writing grant application and evaluating other programs. She is a frequent presenter at conferences and seminars.
