Keith Hanson, a Bossier native and Airline High School graduate, has been writing software since he was 12 years old, but started professionally developing software at 16.

At the age of 19, he was headhunted into Dallas where he spent five years sharpening his teeth on the industry working on large software projects for companies like the New York Times Syndication service and leading teams of developers.

He married a Shreveport native in 2009 and returned home, working remotely for companies from Austin to Washington, D.C. He launched a freelance business that became what Twin Engine Labs is today.

By 2017, Twin Engine Labs has launched three ventures successfully and recently acquired their first non-

tech business in Colorado.

Keith is a founding member of Shreveport Charter Foundation which is the governing board for the new Magnolia School of Excellence Charter School. He also received the 2012 Gold Winner Davey Awards, the 2012 Louisiana Technology Council Growth Company of the Year, the 2011 Louisiana Governor's Technology Rising Star of the Year Award and was the first place winner in the 2011 WalkinApp.com Award.
