Eric Barkley is the chairman of the 2016 Camping World Independence Bowl and has been involved with the Independence Bowl Foundation for many years.

Eric played in the third edition of the Independence Bowl as the starting quarterback for Louisiana Tech against East Carolina in 1978. He finished his playing career at Northwestern State University where he earned his B.A. in mass communications. He also graduated with an M.A. in liberal arts from LSU-S.

Eric's career has taken him to many areas of the Ark-La-Tex, and he currently serves as the North Louisiana district director for CenterPoint Energy.

In addition to volunteering time with Independence Bowl Foundation, Eric is a past chairman of the Shreveport Chamber of Commerce and currently serves on their senior

council. He is on the board of directors of the Shreveport-Bossier Military Affairs Council and was named the 2015 Eagle of the Year for the MAC. He is a member of the Committee of 100 and is a past president of the United Way of North Louisiana.
