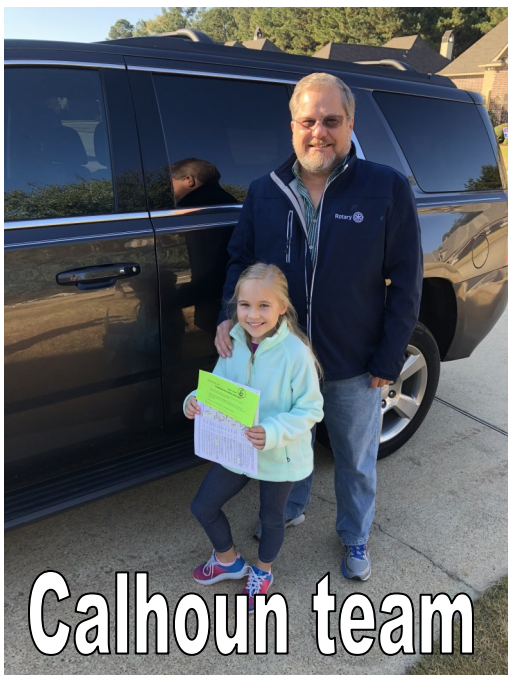

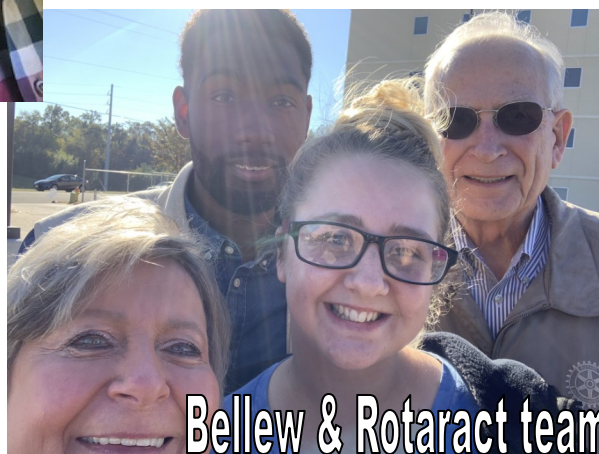

### Reminder About Required Minimum Distributions

If you are over 70 1/2, you are required by federal law to take distributions known as Required Minimum Distributions (or RMDs) from your retirement account.

These distributions may be made tax-free if they are directed to a qualified 501c3 not-for-profit organization.

RMD donations may be made directly to the Rotary Club of Shreveport Foundation, The Rotary Foundation or to other qualified not-for-profit organizations.
