In April 2019 Mayor Perkins appointed **Brandon Fail** as Economic Development Coordinator for the City of Shreveport.

Brandon's aim is to attract high-quality employers, support economic growth and enhance opportunity and prosperity in our city.

After receiving his undergraduate degree in government from Harvard University, Brandon attended Yale Law School where he earned his J.D. degree in 2006.

Upon leaving Yale, he worked with McKinsey & Company in New York as an engagement manager and then founded The Shoplift, an e-commerce social shopping mall. By 2018, Brandon had relocated to Shreveport and opened The Levee, Shreveport's first farm-to-table restaurant.






