Dr. Jeffrey Kerst grew up in Hot Springs, Arkansas. He is the owner of Kerst & Caskey Family Dentistry in Shreveport.

Jeffrey received his B.S. in biology with a minor in chemistry from University of Arkansas at Little Rock. He graduated Magna Cum Laude and was a University Science Scholar.

He then received his Doctorate of Dental Surgery from LSU Health Sciences Center School of Dentistry. He received Honors in Leadership and co-founded a non-profit to promote oral health education. His awards include: Pierre Fauchard Academy Student Certificate of Merit, LSUSD Alumni Association Student Leadership Award, LDA Outstanding Senior Dental Student Award, Delta

Dental Community Care Foundation Student Leadership Award and the American Student Dental Association Award of Excellence.

Jeffrey is a sought after speaker on leadership in the Millennial Generation and has spoken at numerous retreats and meetings as well as provided numerous written publications in dental journals.


