We'll have our annual fun program on Tuesday as we learn about our very own Junior Livestock Auction and the State Fair of Louisiana coming October 25th.



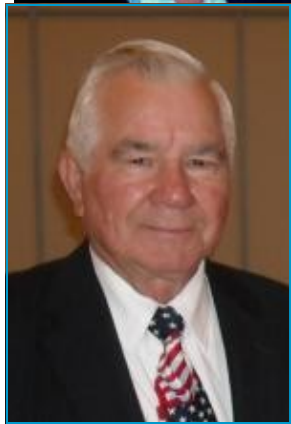
