Active Shooter Situations

On Tuesday, no photos should be taken of the speaker as he is involved in undercover work locally. Please honor his request. Film will be shown so if you have difficulty seeing the side wall where the film is shown, please seat yourself on that side of the room.

Our local FBI Special Agent **Chris Plants** will give us insight on Tuesday into active shooter situations.

Agent Plants has been with the bureau for 15 years. He is a FBI certified firearms instructor and defensive tactics instructor. He served on the FBI SWAT teams in Little Rock, San Antonio and New Orleans for ten years. His career began in the FBI's Little Rock field office where he was responsible for working violent crimes and major of-



fenders which mainly meant gang and drug cases. Agent Plants then transferred to the Del Rio, Texas office on the Mexican border to work cases involving the Mexican drug cartels and Hispanic gangs, such as the Mexican mafia.

In 2010 he transferred to the Shreveport office where he now serves as the child exploitation task force coordinator. He investigates child porn situations, child kidnappings and human trafficking investigations.

Plants has taught defensive tactics, including an active shooter course, on several occasions to law enforcement officers.

James Allen, Jr. Memorial Scholarship Presentation

The James Allen, Jr. Scholarship Award was created in 2003 by our late club member Jimmie Allen and his wife through a bequest to the Rotary Club of Shreveport Foundation, honoring their deceased son, James Allen, Jr. a Centenary alumnus. The stipulation of the bequest was that the income be used to provide an annual scholarship to a deserving Centenary student.

Each year, we ask the Centenary financial aid director to assist us in locating a Centenary student who clearly exhibits the character traits of scholarship, personal integrity, and a dedication to Service Above Self, either through extracurricular activities, career plans, or both.

Jimmie passed away on September 28, 2011 so we try to make the presentation each year to coincide as closely as possible to that date. The scholarship award is for \$2,000.

Our scholarship committee chair Alan Prater introduced this year's recipient, **Ms. Bailey McDonald**. She is a senior, scheduled to graduate in December, majoring in religious studies with an emphasis in sociology. Immediately upon graduation, she will join the staff of Lake-

While at Centenary, she has served as an intern in the office of the Provost; vice-president of her sorority; and in diverse leadership roles, including the reestablishment of the Methodist Student Movement (formerly known as the Wesley Foundation), as an active voice and participant in the Christian Leadership Center, a member of the college's Strategic Planning Committee, and most recently, serving as the assistant to the new college chaplain, our very own Lindy Broderick.

Ms. McDonald was instrumental in the creation of the college's Interfaith Youth Council, where she continues to serve. She was a member of the volleyball team as a freshman and currently enjoys yoga and running.

She is the daughter of Texas Rotarian Jeff McDonald and Mrs. McDonald, who live in the Palestine, TX area.
