Fletch's unique blend of sports and humor has made him a household name in the Ark-La-Tex. He joined KTBS in 1999 as sports director and remained there until early 2014 when he started his own radio show The Tim Fletcher Show where he hosts a three-hour

daily sports/guy talk show live on KWKH AM1130 on Monday through Friday.

As president of the Tim Fletcher Show LLC he also hosts a one-hour high school football highlight show from 10:30-11:30 p.m. each Friday during the season. Highlighted during the show are kids and coaches from East Texas to Caddo/ Bossier and to all points east.

Fletch also starts Season 3 of Friday Football Frenzy from 8-10 p.m. during the high school season on KSHV-My 45 and KEEL-710 AM.


