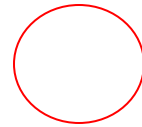
WHAT IS THE PAUL HARRIS SOCIETY?

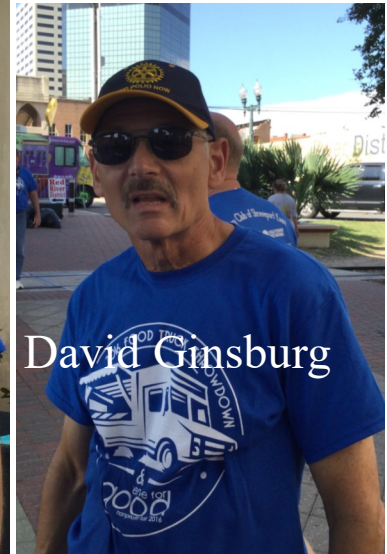
