Cyber Innovation Center



Craig Spohn has 35 years of business experience in the Information Technology field, working in international, commercial and federal government markets. He is the President and Executive Director of the Cyber Innovation Center in Bossier.

Cyber Innovation Center is a public/private initiative whose mission is to support research, education and technology advancement for the cyber domain and to foster collaborative and strategic alliances between governmental agencies, private industry and academic institutions.

Before serving at the Cyber Innovation Center, Craig was the Director of an Information Technology Consulting Group. Prior to returning to Shreveport-Bossier, he was with Science Applications International Corporation, a large defense contractor. While there he served as Vice-President for Middle East Business and coordinated their Saudi Arabian business activities as General Manager of the Saudi Joint Venture.

In 2018, Spohn received an honorary Doctor of Science from Louisiana Tech University. Governor John Bel Edwards appointed him as Chairman of the Louisiana Cybersecurity Commission. He is serving a 2014-2025 term representing the fourth congressional district on the Board of Supervisors of Louisiana's Community and Technical Colleges.

Spohn is involved with other community and service boards such as Military Affairs Council Board of Directors, Ouachita Independent Bank Board of Directors and the Committee of 100.

Craig has been a member of the Rotary Club of Shreveport since 2008. He and his wife Stacy have a son, Sam, and two daughters, Caroline and Sarah-Catherine.
