Michael Buttermann Shreveport Symphony Orchestra

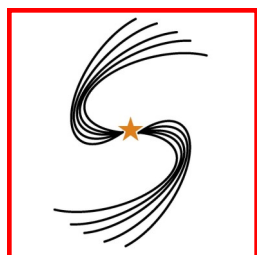
In 2006 **Michael Buttermann** became the music director for the Shreveport Symphony Orchestra. He also serves as the music director for the Boulder Philharmonic Orchestra, that he has led to national prominence.

Buttermann recently completed a 19-year association with the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra as their Principal Conductor for Education and Community Engagement and a 15-year tenure with the Jacksonville Symphony, first as Associate and then as Resident Conductor.

At Indiana University, Mr. Buttermann conducted a highly acclaimed production of Leonard Bernstein's little-known *1600 Pennsylvania Avenue* in a series of performances at the Kennedy Center in Washington, DC, receiving unanimous praise from such publications as *The New York Times*, *Washington Post*, *Variety* and *USA Today*.



He gained international attention as a diploma laureate in the Prokofiev International Conducting Competition and as a finalist in the prestigious Besancon International Conducting Competition.

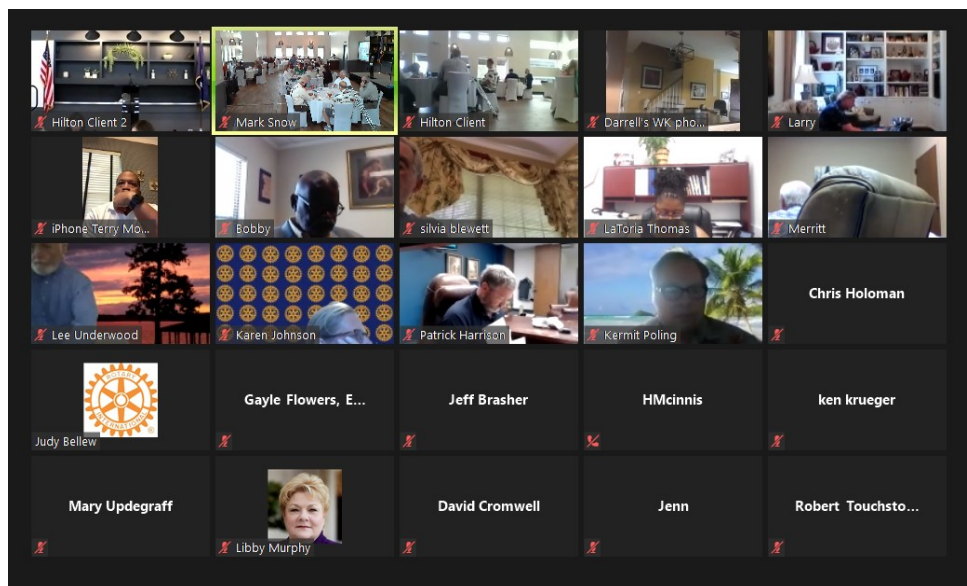

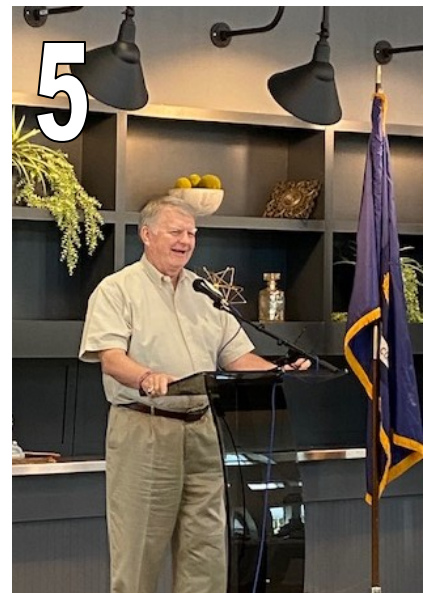
