Every Man A King Distilling

Andrew Larson, M.D. is originally from Church Point, a small town in south Louisiana. He moved to New Orleans for a Tulane chemical engineering degree and then stayed for medical school at LSUHSC.

Larson has been in Shreveport since 2012 upon completion of his anesthesiology residency at the University of Virginia. He has been a partner in his anesthesia SCorp, Medical Center Anesthesiologists, since 2014 and remains the managing partner for their largest contract, Christus Shreveport-Bossier.

In 2016 his wife's practice, Lindsey Pennington MD Facial Plastics, was founded and Larson remains actively involved with the financials and market strategy.

In 2018 Dr. Larson and his wife Dr. Pennington expanded into commercial real estate with the renovation of the former Arlington Hotel, on the corner of Cotton and Louisiana Street. With opening planned for 2020, this location will include a modern French restaurant (The Revenir), and a micro-distillery (Every Man A King) that will be producing handcrafted corn whiskey, vodka, gin, moonshine and bourbon.

Every Man A King Distilling is one of the companies that went through the EAP (Entrepreneurial Accelerator Program, a division of BRF) and has been recognized as one of the Elite 10 startups for 2019.


